Backed to Win £18,000 at Call-Over

HINTS FOR YORK

BETTING over the Cesarewitch is getting really perplexing. A fortnight ago really perplexing. A fortnight ago Chrysler II was favourite, and then Doreen Jane came on the scene. Woodstock will be Captain Boyd-Rochfort's only runner, and at yesterday's call-over he was a clear favourite, and was backed to win about £18,000. Wagers booked over Woodstock were 1,000 to 75 (three times) 1,000 to 80 (twice) 1,000 to 90 (four times) 1,000 to 95 (twice) and 4,000 to 400. Sirett has been engaged to ride Woodstock.

The revised decision of T. Weston to ride Shining Cloud instead of Doreen Jane was reflected in the market. Shining Cloud advanced from 100 to 8 to 100 to 9, finishing on the same mark as Sir Abe Bailey's other candidate. Each was supported to win £3,000.

Not to Accept

Other Cesarewitch news is that Bonny Brighteyes, Coronetot, Apple Peel, Damascus and Piccadilly will not be among the acceptances. Carpet Knight got cast in his box, and also has been struck out. Solitaire runs for the Middleham stable controlled by Harry Peacock. This four-year-old will be ridden by S. Wragg. G. Digby has accepted with Hands Off in preference to Gainslaw and Watertight.

For the Cambridgeshire Pegasus and Law Court figured at 10 to 1, each being supported to win £8,000. Of the others, Gunboat at 28 to 1 and Plymouth Sound at 33's were the best supported. Badruddin, who was favourite at the end of last week, did not go at all well. A bet of £1,000 to £40 was laid and the price again freely offered.

Pepino at Last

Anticipations that Sir Abe Bailey would complete a double in the big races at Nottingham by winning the Trial Plate with Lost Soul were not realised. The filly ran prominently for most of the journey, but failed to finish in the first three. Pepino won the race, and it was his first success of the season. Inflation had command of the field until the last few strides, and then Pepino got up to beat him by a head. Pepino was conceding 14lb. to Inflation, but in the Cambridgeshire the difference is only 12lb.

Tidebrook and Alcazar were the favourites to meet with success. Tidebrook was not winning out of her turn, her previous success being in a nursery at Birmingham two years ago. Eager Gal was the one to give Tidebrook the most trouble, and the verdict went against her by a head. Alcazar also won his race by a head.

To-day's Prospects

According to advices from Newmarket Captain Boyd-Rochfort is unlikely to be represented in the Rockingham Handicap at York to-day, and this leaves us with a very open race to deal with. Lord Glanely will have a fancied runner in Winastep, and there are good reasons for expecting him to be well in the limelight. After finishing first at Nottingham he was disqualified for boring and crossing. Subsequently he defeated a very useful field for the Alexandra Handicap at Doncaster.
