

Hello again! Hope the Easter Bunny leaves some nice models hidden for everyone! This time I'm going to cover some responses to previous column articles. I asked for comments on true horse color terms of H-R current "grey" Arabas. From Patty Gray came a nice note w/a quote from the Amer. Connemara Pony Stud Book. It classifies "lt. dun" as "cream or light tan color. Duns have black manes/tails & generally black on the lower part of the legs. Occasionally duns have black dorsale stripe." Since the H-R's generally have blk. on their legs & points, perhaps they could be called light duns. Or, she suggests, set up a new standard & call these models 'Doeskin' to save on confusion. This is frequently done now. I've discovered in the process of repainting 1 that with a true black m/t/pts, they are quite close to a grulla color... Also received an informative letter from Stephani Robson in B.C. regarding a horse's "points". The points of a horse according to B.H.S., C.H.S.A. & C.P.C. are: mane, tail, legs *** (stockings or socks CAN be there of course), muzzle & eartips. Thanks loads, Patty & Stephani. We really appreciate your research & comments. Also received a note from a collector, which I lost (sorry!) asking if any other breeds apart from the TWH have strawberry roans. To the best of my knowledge most light horse breeds DO. The Arab folks refer to them as rose greys! Any definite info on this out there? (For personal replies, please send SASE, otherwise will just comment from time to time here.)


