



From the pix the breed looks like hunter in some aspects & white markings do occur... KONIK: The nearest domesticated relative to the Tarpan is this 13.1 hh pony. Colors range from yellow, grey & blue duns to bays. The Konik surprisingly enough laid the foundation for almost all breeds of Polish & Russian breeds, at least those found in western Russia. A strong, active & easy keeper, he is in great demand on small farm holdings. In appearance he resembles a Shetland through the body though longer & somewhat thinnner, and the ndck is thick reminding one of an old-time Morgan & the head looks like that of the Fell Pony, of England.... "I don't necessarily agree on racing w/pix instead of by chance. True, in showing realism & good looks are important & that's as it should be. But why can't racing be different, or at least some racing? I personally enjoy the gamble of 'chance' racing & would not be offended if a green 2 yr. old won over 1 of my seasoned 'sharpies'. Besides, if anyone wants to be fair to models, be fair to those that aren't photogenic. I don't see anything wrong w/pic racing, but I don't think it's wrong or unfair to race by chance, either." C

"I'd like to comment on something, that there were 2 models under different names in a show & they were evidently the same model so the judge disqualified one or both. That can happen w/orig.fin. but not repaints because they are 'one-pf-a-kind(, right? WRONG. Many times I've done a rep. for someone & liked it so much I did one just like it for myselfm & in most cases the position or color was so unique that any judge seeing both in the same show w/diff. names would disqualify them. So what do you (Ede The case mentioned in the earlier MHSJ had to do with the same model, not'2 reps; alike. It was the same identical photo in this case, same-named model, etc. I can see how copying 1 rep. from another is a problem, but more than likely some small differences are going to get slipped in. This brings up another question, should people paying for a repaint/remake job expect to have a one-of-a-kind, in the sense that their paid-for model doesn't have an identical twin running around, no matter how much the creator liked it? I would be hopping mad if I knew of a model carrying the identical markings as mine after buying a fancy rep. job, etc. Some repainters keep a photo record on file to avoid accidentally creating such a twin, & when it comes down to it, no two Apps, Pintos, Paints, dappleds, etc. are going to jive exactly in their markings! They can be mighty close, but an exact double, I've heard of none.) *****

"When it comes to judging shows, some people are NOT fair! I entered I show where all I could see pinned were the 'famous horses'. I entered some really nice pix & not 1 of them placed above 10th. All I could see were famous horses abovemy name. I take in mind that they may have dewere famous horses abovemy name. I take in mind that they may how'd the served it, but every class? If every person judged this way how'd the served it, but every class? If every person judged this way how'd the known horses GET 'unknown' horses get known & for that fact, how'd the known horses GET known? Take, for example, *Alconbury Hill. Some people pin him because he's known & Linda's horse. Some people think he wins TOO much & place he known if at all! And Linda knows it. This is strictly UNFAIR. I've notived this in alot of shows... "MD (Ed. he used the name by permission before you all scalp her, ha. I know this is going on & have a report in my hands from a girl who stated the judge didn't place my horse BECAUSe he was my horses—and'won too much! Many times the winners of classes are

NEVER! If I cannot win under my own name, the same for all of you out there, and win with my own horses be they famous! or not, then why show? I know when the gang is deliberately placed low, and that judge will never see 'em again, ha. But to do it deliberately when they should have won the class even in the judge's begrudging opinion, well. This goes for ALL showers/judges, JUDGE THE MODEL, NOT THE NAME OR OWNER? (4)
